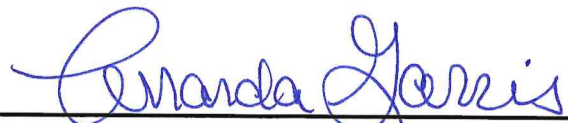
- a. Ray Garriss & Son Construction = \$125,600
