Public Council Meeting Minutes

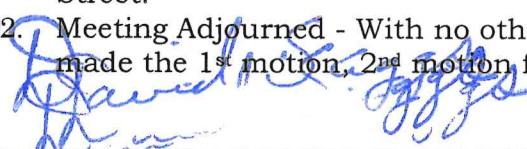
- Welcome – Call meeting to order by Mayor Suggs
2. Pledge of Allegiance with everyone and a Prayer from Mayor Suggs
 3. Meeting Minutes – Request for motion to approve meeting minutes from February 19th & March 4th, 2026, 1st motion from Councilmember Townsend 2nd motion from Councilmember Price, all in favor.
 4. Citizen Concerns: (3 minutes per person)
 - a. Sterling Lee – Community Concerns – Mr. Lee voiced his concerns regarding the request to have the Basketball Courts at the Hilltop park striped to which Council responded that they have been awaiting his response from resident opinions on colors. It was discussed to have the stripes painted white and the court a dark color to which Mayor Suggs stated he will have it completed and will paint it to save the town funding. Mr. Lee also requested that the bathroom door locks be fixed as they had been locked to which Council stated that they were locked due to vandalism and could be unlocked for events if the Town Hall was informed of such an event happening. Mayor Suggs stated that they can stay unlocked all the time. Mr. Lee then requested for ant beds and mulch to be addressed at the park as well and Council said they will look into it.
 5. Committee Reports: Clerk Garriss stated that we are track for the Easter Egg Hunt and next up will be the Spring Festival. She requested feedback from Council on thoughts of food options for the upcoming community supper event as well as recommendations for caterers.
 6. Financial Reports from Clerk Garriss: Balance Sheet, Budget vs. Actual, Grant Discussion reports were all handed out. Clerk Garriss stated that all departments were on track with their percentages for budget, the transfer to the LGIP account has increased revenue tremendously bringing in monthly what used to be brought in annually, she also stated that she was able to secure and receive a \$6k+ generator and welder that was donated from Dillon Harbor Freight to our Town Maintenance Department.

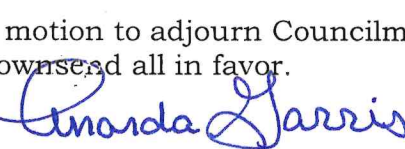
OLD BUSINESS – Mayor Suggs

7. Ordinance Chapter 50 – An ordinance amending Chapter 50 for Refuse Collection to add Section 50.16 Prohibiting the disposal of Human Urine and Fecal Matter in Municipal Refuse Containers and establishing penalties for such – 2nd Reading request for motion to Adopt – 1st motion from Councilmember Townsend 2nd motion from Councilmember King all in favor.
8. Ordinance Chapter 51 – An ordinance clarifying responsibility for maintenance of drainage ditches and natural watercourses following SC State Code Laws – 2nd Reading request for motion to Adopt – 1st motion from Councilmember Church 2nd motion from Councilmember Price all in favor.

NEW BUSINESS – Mayor Suggs

9. Adjustment to Budget Workshop meeting schedule – will meet 1hr prior to each Council meeting for the months of April, May & June.
10. Mayor Report - Mayor Suggs stated that a new sign will be hanging at the Pickleball Court and that he had the new benches placed out there as well. He also built a new rake for cleaning out the pond which has been very helpful. The dirt at the Town Square has been completed and next will be working on the cement and lighting which Mayor Suggs will be assisting with to lower costs. We are still awaiting quote for the stage top. Mayor Suggs has spoken with County Councilmember Townsend who has assisted with getting the incline adjusted on the sidewalks to better suit those in wheelchairs. Mayor Suggs also explained that he has completed himself the necessary repairs at the recreation field to the water and electric including panel box and lock replacements.
11. Council Concerns – Council discussed the need for “No side street parking” & “No unauthorized vehicles beyond this point” signs to be made and posted at the Recreation Fields and along S. Smith Street.
2. Meeting Adjourned - With no other discussions needed, motion to adjourn Councilmember King made the 1st motion, 2nd motion from Councilmember Townsend all in favor.
